## COLCHESTER BOROUGH LOCAL PLAN

About a hundred people were at the Langham Community Centre on 7 February for a presentation by the Langham Parish Council of the Issues and Options part of the Colchester Borough Council's consultation for a new Local Plan. The Local Plan will provide the strategy for the growth of the Borough, setting out what development will take place and where up to and beyond 2032. Once adopted, the new Local Plan will replace the Borough's existing local planning policies.

### COLCHESTER BOROUGH LOCAL PLAN—1: ISSUES & OPTIONS CONSULTATION

Colchester Borough Council (CBC) envisages a consultation and publication timetable for the Local Plan, leading to its examination by a Government Inspector, approval by the Secretary of State and adoption:

A separate sustainable settlement to the **west of Colchester town**  
Urban development on sites in and around the existing urban area  
Proportional development of the Rural District Centres—Wivenhoe, Tiptree and West Mersea  
(Option 2B adds - **A proportional element of rural growth across the Borough's villages**)

#### **Options 3A & B**

A separate sustainable settlement to the **east of Colchester town**  
A significant urban extension to the **north of Colchester town, crossing the A12**  
In addition to an extension to the north, other urban development in and around the existing urban area  
Proportional expansion of the Rural District Centres—Wivenhoe, Tiptree and West Mersea  
(Option 3B adds - **A proportional element of rural growth across the Borough's villages**)

In 2014, in preparation for the new Local Plan, CBC invited submissions of sites for future allocation (the "Call for Sites"). The outcome for Boxted is shown on the section for "North Colchester" and for Langham on the section "Langham & Fordham Heath". (See also page 4.)

## BOXTED AIRFIELD HISTORICAL GROUP

In March the Group will enjoy a presentation by Richard Turner on the Roger Freeman Collection. Freeman, who lived nearly all his life at Dedham, was the leading authority, recognized as such world-wide, on the history of the United States 8th Air Force based in East Anglia during World War II. His collection of 15,000 prints and slides is deposited at the Imperial War Museum. The presentation will also reveal documents and letters donated to the Boxted Airfield Museum.

## BOXTED HISTORY GROUP

The History Group has had a number of memorable meetings over the past year or so. Talks have ranged from World War 1 through the Dedham Vale AONB and Charles Dickens' London to the history of Ransome & Rapier at Ipswich.

In January Tim Jenkins returned to speak of his "life" as 19th century footman Thomas Clements at Kentwell Hall, Long Melford. "Thomas" recounted a typical day's duties, which included serving the family at meals, attending to guests at the house and its garden parties. All these tasks were performed against what seemed an endless round of cleaning and polishing cutlery and silverware.

There is much to look forward to in this year's programme. The Group meets on the third Wednesday of the month at Boxted Village Hall and membership is a mere £7 a year, which allows free entry to meetings and includes light refreshments.

## COLCHESTER BOROUGH LOCAL PLAN—2

Boxted Parish Council has commended the model below for use by Boxted residents to contribute their comments on the Issues & Options presented for consultation:

*I note from the Colchester Borough Council Local Plan Issues and Options Consultation paper that options 3A and 3B provide for development North of the A 12 on land in or adjacent to the villages of Boxted and Langham (and therefore further encroaching upon the Dedham Vale AONB)*

*The residents of Boxted have recently been canvassed for their views in relation to their Neighbourhood Development Plan. There has been overwhelming support (94%) for the maintenance of a clear green boundary between Boxted and Colchester to maintain the village identity of Boxted.*

*I deplore the inclusion of Options 3A and 3B in the Issues and Options Consultation Paper and would request that these Options be removed from the plan.*

Langham Parish Council is currently engaged in framing its own response to the consultation process.

### 3-2-1 CYCLE
