## LANGHAM:

### "GARDEN VILLAGE"?

Readers of the Essex County Standard (ECS) will have seen in its 13 March issue a press release on behalf of unnamed "principal landowners" for the development of a 4,000-home "garden village" in Langham. The ECS article stated that the development would include, in addition to housing, business parks, a new primary school, a "garden village centre" and a country park. It would occupy the area bounded by the A12 Trunk Road to the east, Perry Lane-School Road to the north, Langham Lane to the west and Salary Brook to the south.

An outline map has been lodged as part of the Call for Sites stage of the Issues and Options consultation phase of compiling the Borough Council's draft Local Plan, described in the March issue of the Newsletter. Apart from the information in the press release no details are available.



Dafydd Lampard of School Road, Langham, plans to climb Africa's highest mountain to raise funds for Help for Heroes in memory of his father, the late Warwick Lampard, who died last year after suffering constant pain for many years. ## BOXTED HISTORY GROUP

Many of those who attended February's meeting were of the age to recall or actually to have visited the subject of Geoffrey Kay's talk: the 1951 Festival of Britain. The evening thus witnessed a lively exchange of reminiscences, during which a number of generally unknown facts emerged. Planned for the hundredth anniversary of the 1851 Great Exhibition, its purposes were to promote British industry and its exports and to raise public morale in the post-war period of austerity. Indeed, it was initially billed as "The Tonic for the Nation", an uninspiring description soon abandoned.



Originally to be sited in Hyde Park (like the Great Exhibition), it was re-located to a derelict bomb site on the south bank of the River Thames by Waterloo Bridge. Despite much scepticism shortage of materials and many labour disputes, the Festival opened on time and was a huge success. 12 million people visited it and souvenirs are still to be found in homes throughout the land. When the Festival ended almost everything was demolished; all that is now left is the Festival Hall. But those who went will not forget the Dome of Discovery, the 3D Cinema and the symbolic "Skylon" (above).
