A referendum was held in Boxted Village Hall on 15th September with villagers voting whether or not they wished Colchester Borough Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Boxted when deciding planning applications in the neighbourhood area. The result was 305 in favour of using the Neighbourhood Plan, with 69 against. Of those eligible to vote, 34.59% did so.
