Happy Pentecost! On 9th June, this year, fifty days after Easter Day, the church celebrates its birthday, and remembers when the Holy Spirit alighted on the disciples who were gathered together to celebrate the Jewish Feast of Weeks.

Jesus had ascended into heaven ten days earlier, on the day we call Ascension Day, promising that he would send the Holy Spirit, to be with the disciples. This is exactly what happened. It was an amazing time when it sounded as though a roaring wind was filling the house, and it looked as though there was a flame on the head of each followers of Jesus. None of them was harmed in any way but instead, prompted by the Holy Spirit, they started talking in other languages, so that everyone in Jerusalem could understand them telling the story of Jesus and his life. Many believed that Jesus was the Saviour sent into the world, by God, to save it from its evil, both individual and corporate. This was the day that the church grew exponentially, and so it is considered the birthday of the worldwide church.

This year on 9th June, we too will be celebrating the arrival of the Holy Spirit who came with great power all those years ago, and continues to come us today, filling us with God's power, and giving us his love and wisdom. Langham Heritage Group

This June marks 75 years since the D-Day Allied Invasion of Normandy, the story below, *A Near Miss*, from the beginning of World War 2.

On 16/08/1940 a flight of German bombers abandoned their sortie to London and made for home. To increase their speed and agility they jettisoned about 100 bombs into the fields of Boxted and Langham.

There were very few people in Wick Road in those days, there were about three houses on one side and just the council houses but nothing on the other side. It was all fields, and there weren't even orchards.

"Mother was taking me for a walk in Wick Road and I was in the pram. It was just after all those bombs, and we had come back from being evacuated. I was only very small, there were some bombers coming straight down the road, hitting everything, civilians, no matter what, firing guns out of the planes. The passing postman said to my mother 'get into the ditch or you are going to be fired at, you are going to be killed'.

It was horrific. They came down the road firing their guns. You know that close with the house called Barnacles, then it was just an open field gate so my mother pushed the pram through and turned it upside down with me in it. She lay down in the ditch beside me as they went over, firing all round, but they missed us. She then just got up and walked on."
